- Thomas Ms Impressive 0641 just hit \$1,000,000 in progeny sales! Her list of progeny accomplishments in the show ring and the high sellers that she has produced would simply be a short novel. The success that she has compiled is without question astonishing. Not just for the Charolais circles, but as compared to every successful cow in any registry. She could very easily be the most productive cow of any breed in the current time of purebred beef cattle production.
- The Lot B embryo mating has produced five of the last eight National Champion Charolais titles—bulls and heifers. She produced the 2011 National Champion Bull and Female and the 2012 Champion Charolais Female at the American Royal that recently sold for a combined value of \$70,000, shown by Effling and purchased by Justin Garwood. This mating produced other notable recent champions, including the 2011 Champion Female at the National Western Stock Show, 2010 National Champion Female, plus other major winners. This footnote is simply a difficult one to write and not leave something out. In addition to these champions, this mating has produced numerous cattle selling over the \$50,000 mark. Just in this past season, this mating has produced a \$26,000 heifer and several others selling from \$5,000 to \$16,000. Not only is 0641 a featured Embryos on Snow donor dam, but the owners will not sell any other sexed female embryos sired by Fire Water this year out of 0641, not in any other sales or off the farm. This in itself adds incredible value to this lot.
- The embryos selling in Lot C are full sibs to the 2012 Ak-Sar-Ben Grand Champion Steer. This mating could become just as dominating as the Lot B mating if early indications tell us anything. This winning steer, sired by Monopoly, was one of only two born in 2011 out of 0641, and her first mating to a club calf sire. Last year's EOS sale featured some of the first Monopoly x 0641 eggs. In 2012, there were only three heifer calves born, selling for an average of over \$15,000 per head, with one recently being named the Champion Char Composite at the Badger.
- A few years ago in Denver, a one-third interest in 0641 sold for \$60,000 in the Charolais in the Rockies Sale. Hang on tight here! This is one of the most impressive and powerful lots of genetics to sell anywhere in the country.
